

Static Cling Installation

Static Cling is very easy to install. When proper care is taken, static cling can be removed and re-used for a long time. Do not use harsh cleaners on the vinyl. Save the backing paper to put the vinyl on when it is removed. Alternative storage would be to place on your refrigerator or other flat metal surface. Use an application fluid. Our home brew works fine. Mix 32oz of water and 3 drops dish soap to a spray bottle and mix. Follow the easy steps below.

1. Clean surface normally. Use a wax & grease remover if it's been waxed.
2. Spray surface liberally with application fluid.
3. Remove vinyl from backing paper. Remember to save it.
4. Apply vinyl to surface.
5. The wet surface will allow you to position the vinyl where you want.
6. When it's in position, use a rubber squeegee to remove the water from between the vinyl and surface.
7. Let dry completely.

** The more water you remove, the better the bond will be.

** Apply letters a day or two before the event if possible. This will allow them to dry completely.

To remove:

1. Clean the vinyl before removing. Pay attention to the edges. Dirt will accumulate here.
2. Use your fingernail or other soft edge to lift the vinyl.
3. Once you can get a good grip, slowly peel vinyl off surface.
4. Re-apply to the original backing paper or other suitable surface.
